Greenwood Campground



May – September

Owned and operated by the Town of Sundre, Greenwood Campground is located two blocks south of the traffic lights. The campground is open for the May long weekend and typically closes late September.

Situated on the west bank of the Red Deer River, the campground is well treed and separated from the town by a grass buffer.

Not only is this campground located right on the river's edge, it is adjacent to the Sundre Museum which is home to the Chester Mjolsness World of Wildlife Exhibit.

Within walking distance, guests can enjoy a variety of services catering to their needs. If you are craving a cappuccino or an ice cream, looking to check your email at a cafe, enjoy a hearty meal, restock your food supply – it's only a short walk away.

Note: The Public often venture near the campground to take advantage of the Day Use area, the Playground and the Trail System.

General Information

Campfires are limited to fireboxes & rings; no open fires. Fire Bans are enforced.

Only one camping unit per site. Additional units are subject to additional charges (inc. tents).

Registration is limited to 14 consecutive nights.



Reservations

Reservations for individual sites and for groups are accepted by the campground host on a first come first serve basis. Groups shall appoint a representative who will be responsible for the respective group to ensure proper use of the facilities.

Campground host will require a Visa / MasterCard number to hold reservations. No payments will be processed until reservation is fulfilled or for an unapproved cancellation.

Cancellation Policy: Approved cancellation – more than 48 hours notice or Family/Medical Emergencies.

Unapproved Cancellations: Less than 48 hours notice & “No Shows” and due to weather.

Any unapproved cancellations will be charged the first night of the reservation. The cancellation fee will be processed on your Visa/MasterCard.
