

## **TOWN OF SUNDRE**

### **BY-LAW NO. 710**

***A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUNDRE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND PROVISIONS OF A CURFEW.***

***WHEREAS, under the provisions of Part 2, Division 1, Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Sundre has the authority to pass such a By-Law.***

***AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Sundre is of the opinion that it would be in the best interests of the residents of the Town of Sundre that a By-Law be passed to regulate the time after which a child shall not be in a public place at night without a guardian present.***

***NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Sundre, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:***

***THIS BY-LAW MAY BE CITED AS THE "CURFEW BY-LAW"***

#### ***I. DEFINITIONS***

- 1. a. "Child" means a person fifteen (15) years of age or under.***
- b. "Public Place" includes any place to which the public have access as of right or by invitation, express or implied.***
- c. "Peace Officer" means a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, or a By-Law Enforcement Officer or Special Constable for the Town of Sundre.***

#### ***II. INFRACTIONS***

- 2. a. No child shall be in a public place in the Town of Sundre between the hours of 11:00 o'clock p.m. and 6:00 o'clock a.m. of any day without proper guardianship or supervision of a parent or guardian.***

**b. A child found in a public place after the time set out in 2(a) may be warned to go home by any peace officer, by-law officer, or special constable, and if after such warning the child is found loitering in a public place, the child may be taken by the peace officer, by-law officer, special constable to the child's home or referred to an appropriate agency.**

**c. Any parent or guardian who permits his/her child to contravene this By-Law is guilty of offence and liable upon summary conviction to:**

**(a) for first offence No Penalty;**

**(b) for a second offence to a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) dollars; and**

**(c) for a third offence to a fine of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars; and**

**(d) for a fourth or subsequent offence to a fine of Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars, and in each case in default of payment to a term of imprisonment not more than three (3) months.**

**By-Law No. 646 is hereby repealed.**
