## SUNDRE WINS COMMUNITY ECO ACTION CHALLENGE

SUNDRE, ALBERTA – The Town of Sundre is excited to announce that it won the Community Eco Action Challenge. The Town of Sundre would also like to congratulate the City of Camrose and Village of Breton for winning in their respective categories in the Community Eco Action Challenge.

The Challenge officially began May 31 and closed June 30, 2010. It encouraged residents of Alberta to make simple changes in their daily lives in order to make a big impact on the environment. Fourteen Communities took part in the province-wide challenge. The challenge was initiated by the City of Airdrie who partnered with AUMA, One Simple Act and Earth Day Canada.

Winning municipalities were named in three size-related categories (small, mid sized and large sized municipalities) based on the number of participants signed up per capita.
