

Greenwood Campground COVID-19 Rules and Regulations

- No transactions will be allowed in cash; only Debit, Mastercard, and Visa will be accepted.
- > Only self-contained RV units will be allowed to register at our campground.
- ➤ No individual tenting will be allowed.
- Individuals should not enter the campground if they are experiencing symptoms including cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat that are not related to pre-existing illness or health condition, or are otherwise required to isolate or quaratine. If you aren't feeling well, please stay home.
- ➤ Washrooms/shower house and Cookhouse shelter shall remain closed.
- Sanitize contact surfaces before and after use at Potable Water fill and Sani-Station. Bringing alcohol-based sanitizer is recommended for hand hygiene when soap and water are not available. You are to provide your own PPE (gloves, masks, etc.) as needed for utilizing the Campground.
- ➤ To meet physical distancing requirements, only members of the same household or cohort family should stay together on a campsite.
- Picnic Tables
 - Use a cloth/cover on the table.
 - o Table will be cleaned with anti-viral product between overnight guests.
- Follow Physical Distancing at all times, particularly at the gazebo, and playground.
- Pedestrians (including bicycles) can utilize trails (including roadways) and the gazebo area within the campground. Pedestrians must not linger in the park or attempt to visit any campsites.
- Quiet hours 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
 - Gates will be locked, vehicle access unavailable. If you need out between these hours please ensure your vehicle is outside of the gates.
- Please keep pets on a leash and cleanup after them at all times. The owner of any pet is liable for the damages suffered by any person while anywhere in this campground.
- Please keep consumption of liquor contained within your campsite.
- Please keep fires within the designated firepits in each site. FIRE BANS ENFORCED.
- FIREWORKS PROHIBITED as per Town of Sundre Bylaw 763.
- Please check out by 11:00 a.m.

As always, it is up to you, our visitors, to camp responsibly during this time of COVID-19. Maintain a social distance of a least six feet, do not gather in groups and wash your hands.

Failure to adhere to policies and Public Health Orders will result in the immediate expulsion from the campground, with no refund issued.
